
QUAD OR TRIPLE MOUNT MAILBOX POST ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT! Before installing your Whitehall mailbox posts, consult your local branch of the US Post Office for road set back and height requirements from roadbed or curb. See Figure 1.



- (See Diagram 1)
- Consult MISDIG for possible interference with underground utilities.
- Dig holes 58" on center (45.332" for Triple Mounts). Determine depth of holes using the Post Office height requirement (X), subtracting the height from the top of the cross bar to the bottom of the post. I.E...60" - X = Hole Depth. (See Figure 4)
- Place post assembly in holes and partially backfill. Position for level on cross bar and plumb on vertical post. NOTE: Double check set back measurement.
- Complete back fill of the post holes packing the earth firmly. *Note: For permanent* installation, use concrete mix to backfill unless it is against local post office or county road commission guidelines.
